Fishing will be restricted to within 5 miles of

the Door County shoreline with the southern

boundary being a line running from Brown

boundary being Gills Rock (N45*17'38.9724", W-87*1'23.0376") again, maintaining the 5-

mile limit. Waters within 1.5 miles of Chambers Island may be fished. No fishing

permitted east of buoys #5 & #6 at the US

Coast Guard Station located toward Lake

Michigan from Sturgeon Bay. There will be no

fishing allowed in Lake Michigan. Any waters

within these boundaries posted "off limits" or

"no fishing" by state or federal agencies will

be off limit. Any live release areas established

by the Tournament Director will be off limits.

That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at the pre-tournament briefing.

Only that water open to all public fishing will

be considered tournament waters. Any

waters closed to public fishing will be closed
