Fish Limits

Fish size: 12" on Largemouth, Smallmouths. Only ONE fish can be weighed per person per session. Only 2 fish in the live well per person at any time. Culling is allowed

NO LIVE BAIT IS ALLOWED, NO trolling is allowed. 1 rod per person in use.

NO dead fish will be weighed.

<u>Launch/Weigh-In</u> MAIN WEIGH IN LOCATION

First cast is at 6:00am - Top 3 OVERALL winners must be present Sunday Aug 7 for Polygraph Info.

You MUST be in the marked weigh in area with fish & proof of ID & days entry.

NO dead fish will be weighed.

Timed Session Weigh-ins Each Day:

Session #1 -6:00 -8:00 a.m. Session #2 - 8:01 -10:00 a.m. Session #3 - 10:01 -12:00 p.m. Session #4 - 12:01 -2:00 p.m.

Total places and prizes awarded in **each session** are based on final number of entries.

Competition waters shall be Big Stone Lake ONLY. All PUBLICALLY accessible waters connecting to the abovementioned waters. Any waters within these boundaries posted "off limits" or "no fishing" by state or federal agencies will be off limits. Live release areas established by the Event Director will be off limits. Additional off limits may be announced at the pre-tournament briefing. Only that water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply

Required Safety Equipment

It is each anglers responsibility to CHECK all required equipment Daily.

Any of the following may be checked, at any weigh in **be prepared**: Fishing License, # fish per angler, life jackets; 1 throwable PFD; NO alcohol in the boat, and functioning kill switch.
