Fish Limits

Fish size: Large and smallmouth 15 inches and over. Only ONE fish can be weighed per person per session. Only 2 fish in the live well per person at any time. Culling is allowed, culling a DEAD bass is prohibited.

NO LIVE BAIT IS ALLOWED, NO trolling is allowed. 1 rod per person in use.

Follow Wisconsin Regulations.

<u>Launch/MAIN Weigh-In</u> <u>Launch Location</u>:

Any Ramp within the boundaries

First cast is at 6:00am - Top 3 OVERALL winners must be present Sun. Sept. 10 for prize pick up and Polygraph Info.

You MUST be in the marked weigh in line with your fish and required weigh in documents\ID by session cut off time. **NO** exceptions.

NO dead fish will be weighed.

Sessions ALL Weigh-in locations:

Session #1 - 6:00a.m.-8:00 a.m. Session #2 - 8:01 a.m. - 10:00 a.m. Session #3 - 10:01 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. Session #4 - 12:01a.m. - 2:00 p.m.

Places, cash and prizes awarded each session are based on entries and will published when registration closes Saturday night.

2:30pm Sept 8 Awards distribution to immediately follow last weigh in at Sawyer Park. Top 3 overall must attend. All others CAN be mailed.

Required Safety Equipment

It is the responsibility of all anglers to have and to daily CHECK all required state and federal safety equipment on board.

Any of the following can be checked, at any weigh in **be prepared**: Fishing License, # fish per angler, life jackets; 1 throwable PFD; NO alcohol in the boat, and functioning kill switch.

Boundaries

Fishing will be restricted to within 5 miles of the Door County shoreline with the southern boundary being a line running from Brown County (N44*40'39.6510", W-87*59'5004") to the Kewaunee County line (N44*40'36.8898", W- 87*44'8026") and the boundary being Gills (N45*17'38.9724", Rock 87*1'23.0376") again, maintaining the 5mile limit. Waters within 1.5 miles of Chambers Island may be fished. No fishing permitted east of buoys #5 & #6 at the US Coast Guard Station located toward Lake Michigan from Sturgeon Bay. There will be no fishing allowed in Lake Michigan. Any waters within these boundaries posted "off limits" or "no fishing" by state or federal agencies will be off limit. Any live release areas established by the Tournament Director will be off limits. That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at the pre-tournament briefing. Only that water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to public will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply.
