Any waters within these boundaries posted "off limits" or "no fishing" by state or federal agencies will be off limits. Live release areas established by the Event Director will be off limits. Additional off limits may be announced at the pre-tournament briefing. Only that water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply</p> <p>Required Safety Equipment It is each angler's responsibility to CHECK all required equipment Daily.</p> <p>Any of the following may be checked, at any weigh in be prepared: Fishing License, # fish per angler, life jackets; 1 throwable PFD; NO alcohol in the boat, and functioning kill switch.</p>
<p>Fish Limits Fish size: 12" on Largemouth, Smallmouths. Only ONE fish can be weighed per person per session. Only 2 fish in the live well per person at any time.
